SUBJECT: **SB 1525 - HB 1247**

This bill, if enacted, provides placement of directional signs for "Salem Cemetery Battlefield" on Interstate 40, at exit 85, both eastbound and westbound.

The fiscal impact from enactment of this bill, is estimated to result in a one-time increase in state expenditures from the Highway Fund of \$10,000 for the erection of two (2) interstate signs @ \$3,500 each and two (2) ramp signs @ \$1,500 each.

This act shall become operative only if the federal highway administrator advises the commissioner of transportation in writing that the provisions of this act shall not render Tennessee in violation of federal laws and regulations.
