

## **FISCAL NOTE**

SUBJECT: **SB 1737 - HB 1718**

This bill, if enacted, will not allow a municipal airport, whether operated by an authority or by other means and whether operated by a single municipality or as a joint enterprise, to be located so that any part of the property is within 18,000 feet of a Native American Indian burial ground.

The fiscal impact from enactment of this bill is estimated to be an increase in local government expenditures to the extent that local governments have already chosen a site that would be in violation of this act. There appears to be at least one such occurrence. It is assumed that enactment of this bill would not affect existing airports or those airports where construction has begun. The amount of increase cannot be reasonably determined but is estimated not to be significant.
