SUBJECT: **SB 1758 - HB 1773**

This bill, if enacted, will permit the district attorney general to use prior delinquent acts that would constitute a felony if committed by an adult to enhance the sentence of an adult offender as a multiple, persistent or career offender.

The fiscal impact from enactment of this bill is estimated to be an increase in state expenditures for enhanced sentencing. The amount of increase cannot be reasonably determined, since the number of defendants with juvenile offenses and whether these offenses will be used in sentencing is unknown; however, the fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
