SUBJECT: **SB 2081 - HB 2775**

This bill, if enacted, will change the definition of a "home for the aged" to "assisted living facility" and a "home for the aged resident" to an "assisted living facility resident". This eliminates the current restriction that residents not be ill or physically or mentally unable to care for themselves and authorizes the Board for Licensing Health Care Facilities to promulgate appropriate regulations.

The fiscal impact from enactment of this bill is estimated to be an increase in state expenditures for promulgation of new rules and printing of new forms. The amount of such increase is estimated to be not significant.
