SUBJECT: **SB 2160 - HB 2507**

This bill, if enacted, repeals statutes which authorize lawyers to sit as special judges in trial and general sessions court.

The fiscal impact from enactment of this bill is estimated to result in a decrease in local government expenditures for any county which by resolution by the county legislative body compensates a special judge sitting in general sessions court. The amount of this decrease in local government expenditures is estimated to be not significant.
