SUBJECT: **SB 2808 - HB 3129**

This bill, if enacted, will require the Board of Nursing to establish continuing education requirements for registered and licensed nurses.

The fiscal impact of this bill is estimated to increase state expenditures by \$59,800, of which \$54,900 is recurring and \$4,900 one-time.

The Department of Health estimates the need for two staff members; one to review a ten percent sample of all license renewals for compliance with the requirements and one attorney position to investigate and prosecute the estimated 400 licenses that fail to meet the standard.

The fiscal impact is also estimated to increase state revenues by \$60,000 in increased license fees to cover the expenditures to the Board of Nursing.
