

## **FISCAL NOTE**

SUBJECT: **SB 3004 - HB 2874**

This bill, if enacted, will allow former non-teacher employees of the Tennessee Appalachia Education Cooperative to become members of the retirement system and to receive credit for prior service rendered to the Cooperative. The bill provides that to participate, the governing body of the county or counties in which the cooperative is located must pass a resolution authorizing the membership and accepting the liability therefor.

The fiscal impact on local governments from enactment of this bill in and of itself is estimated to be minimal since the provisions of the bill are permissive.

The fiscal impact from enactment of this bill is estimated to be an increase in local government expenditures to the extent affected former teachers are permitted by local governments to establish prior service and elect to establish such prior service. The amount of such increase cannot be determined but is estimated to be not significant.
