SUBJECT: **SB 3035 - HB 2937**

This bill, if enacted, will add Hamilton County to those counties permitted to appoint one or more judicial commissioners.

The fiscal impact on local governments from enactment of this bill in and of itself is estimated to be minimal since the provisions of the bill are permissive.

The fiscal impact from enactment of this bill is estimated to be an increase in local government expenditures to the extent that Hamilton County chooses to appoint judicial commissioners, the number of commissioners they appoint, and the salary set for the appointees. Such increase cannot be determined but is estimated to exceed \$100,000 if two or more commissioners are appointed.
