SUBJECT: **SB 3199 - HB 3202**

This bill, if enacted, will change the definition of *Premiere Type Tourist Resort* for liquor by the drink for on premises consumption purposes, from requiring the facility to have and maintain 200 rooms to requiring the facility to have and maintain 150 rooms.

The fiscal impact from enactment of this bill is estimated to be an increase in state and local government revenues to the extent that there exist facilities which will meet the room requirements, and will receive a liquor-by-the-drink license, that would not meet such requirements in the absence of the bill. Such increases cannot be determined but are estimated to be not significant.
