Election Laws - As introduced, requires a voter to present qualified photographic identification before voting; voters without proper identification shall be allowed to cast provisional ballots. - Amends TCA Title 2, Chapter 7, Part 1.

***SB 0027 by *Tracy, Woodson (HB 0150 by *Carr)**

Lottery, Charitable - As introduced, extends deadline for applications for 2010-2011 annual events for five days after effective date of act. - Amends TCA Title 3, Chapter 17, Part 1.

***SB 0034 by *Burks (HB 0047 by *Sexton, Lundberg, Brooks H, Haynes, Cobb , Matlock, Dean, Maggart, Elam, Niceley)**

Flags - As introduced, requires state flags to be flown at half-staff by political subdivisions during day of mourning declared by the governor for Tennessee national guard members killed in action. - Amends TCA Title 4, Chapter 1, Part 4.
