SUMMARY OF BILL: Enacts *The Isbill Act*. Requires the Peace Officer Standards and Training Commission (POST) and Tennessee Corrections Institute (TCI) to adopt guidelines and materials instructing law enforcement officers (LEOs) and correctional personnel on the criteria for emergency and nonemergency involuntary admissions to inpatient treatment and requires law enforcement officers and correctional personnel to undergo annual training on those guidelines and materials. Effective July 1, 2027.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 38-8-104, the POST is required to develop, plan, and implement training programs for all LEOs in the state.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 41-7-103, the TCI is required to train correctional personnel in the methods of delivering correctional services in municipal, county and metropolitan jurisdictions.
- The proposed legislation requires the POST and the TCI to adopt guidelines and materials instructing LEOs and correctional personnel, respectively, on the criteria for emergency and nonemergency involuntary admissions to inpatient treatment. Additionally, the legislation provides for recurring annual training thereof.
- The POST and the TCI can adopt the proposed new guidelines into existing training processes and with existing resources.
- The impact to state and local government is estimated to be not significant.
